	Richard Johnson has received information from SC about proposed changes to Bridgend and Bridge Street. Changes include raising zebra crossing, introduction of cycle lanes, changes to the speed humps and installation of a bollard island. Comments included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It looks like a waste of money • Discontinuous cycle lanes are a disaster • No history of accidents • No information why this is being introduced • Not improving safe route to school Richard Johnson will arrange a meeting of local residents and SC in CYP on 26 th January to discuss.
