Ancaster Square Cover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • R.Johnson confirmed the planning application for the canopy over the square had been withdrawn but no acknowledgement from the National Park • T.Jones confirmed that the planning application for the Victorian Pavilion was now live • Callander Community Councillors will meet privately to discuss the application
Bridgend	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nicole Paterson (SC) has agreed to a strategic review to be drafted by CCC • R.Johnson has met with the head teacher of the Primary School to discuss the proposals • Noted that the vehicle speed data has been requested from SC but not received. • Noted that the number of speed cushions will be reduced by SC as they should be at 100m spacings • R.Watt commented that speed bumps reduce speed but increase the risk of accident although reduced speed also reduces the severity of the injury – need the data from SC as the median speed could be below 20mph but still some vehicles in excess of 20mph. Speed bumps can also make vehicle movement unpredictable so this can confuse pedestrians. Need a system to slow vehicles to a constant speed without requiring driver to constantly check speed dial. Possibly link the 20mph limit in Bridgend with a similar restriction along Main Street. • Need to address the weight of vehicles – R.Johnson to contact FCS about their logging lorries not using Bridgend.

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
