

## LPP – report from RJW

Preparations for the LPP process continue. Helen Terry has put a lot of work into organizing the steering group, which is almost complete. Key aspects of progress are given here in summary.

### 1. Personnel

The steering group now has representation from a broad range of background:

### 2. Consultation

The initial stage of consultation is proposed to be a set of focus groups, each comprising 5-6 residents of the town. The results of this will then feed into wider and deeper consultation:

1. Newcomers. People who have moved to Callander within the past 5 years
2. Young families with children at primary school
3. Older families with children at high school
4. Callander residents aged 65+ or retired
5. Residents living in IMD data zones 13,16,14,15 – this can be refined later
6. Single residents – mixed age groups
7. High School pupils from senior years
8. Business owners – proportional representation, not all B&B owners
9. Arts and culture groups based in Callander
10. Volunteers

Questions for these focus groups will be open ended and will vary between groups but will concern the quality of life here, perceptions of the community, the main street, external statutory organisations, social cohesion and, opportunities available to residents.

It may be good to thank each participant for their time with a £10 voucher for use in any hospitality outlet in Callander (and organized through CE).
