Ward Plan Priorities

Antisocial Behaviour

You are concerned about antisocial behaviour including drunken behaviour.

On the evening of 31st October, 2021, a reported was received of a disturbance in the street in the Callander area. This involved several people and Police are currently investigating with a view to identifying witnesses and those responsible.

On the evening of 1st November, 2021, one male was arrested in Main Street, Callander for threatening and abusive behaviour, assaulting Police officers to their injury, and resisting arrest. He is the subject of a report to the fiscal.

Road Safety

You are concerned about speeding, dangerous driving and indiscriminate parking.

Reports have been received of an apparently abandoned car in Station Road, Callander. Although the vehicle is parked in part of the disabled bay, its documents are in order. We have no legal powers to uplift this vehicle. Blue badge holders are still able to legally park in the remaining part of the disabled bay and on the double yellow lines in the area.
