GENERAL

Since the 14 February meeting, the main focus and activity has been on carrying forward the major items which came up at that meeting. A general account of our work was sent to the BLV for their April/May issue.

1. FLOODING: STIRLING COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PLAN + LOCAL INPUT

The consultation period on the Draft Engagement Plan has been extended to 14.03.22, in order to get as much community input as possible. We are keeping closely in touch with the SC Floods officer and with groups such as the Bridgend, South Church Street and Grant Court group on all stages and hope to report on the developments at the meeting.

2. BRACKLINN BRIDGE DEVELOPMENTS (LLTNP)

Together with our Associate Member, Alasdair Wyllie, and two CCDT Directors, we held an update meeting with the LLTNP staff involved practically in the project development today, and will report on this at the meeting. Lines of communication have been clarified...

3. CALLANDER SOUTH DEVELOPMENTS

The architects involved in this project gave a presentation at the Callander Partnership meeting on 11 February. They held a follow-up meeting on details, especially on footpaths and the footbridge development and we are awaiting their final report at the end of March.

4. MOTORHOMES PARKING: EXPERIMENTAL PROJECT STATION ROAD CAR

At a meeting with two Stirling Council representatives, and one from the LLTNP, an experimental project involving two dedicated spaces and the provision of waste water disposal was discussed for implementation this season.. Given the number of legal procedures and different bodies involved in establishing anything more permanent, this will be run as an experiment and community feedback sought.

Discussions are still underway on the practical details and an update will be provided at or shortly after the meeting.

5. EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING: CAMP PLACE PLAY PARK

An EGM was held on 09.03 to agree the terms of the contract with LLTNP for the grant for this development . This was passed and duly minuted.

OTHER

We are keeping in touch on the LPP progress and developments and are looking forward to its next stage.

AGM

The AGM will take place on 11 April. Following Stirling Council's Scheme of Establishment, all the Office Bearers will stand down. The voting process will be run by a Stirling Council Officer, and the four posts (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary and Treasurer) will be voted on by all the Full Members present.
