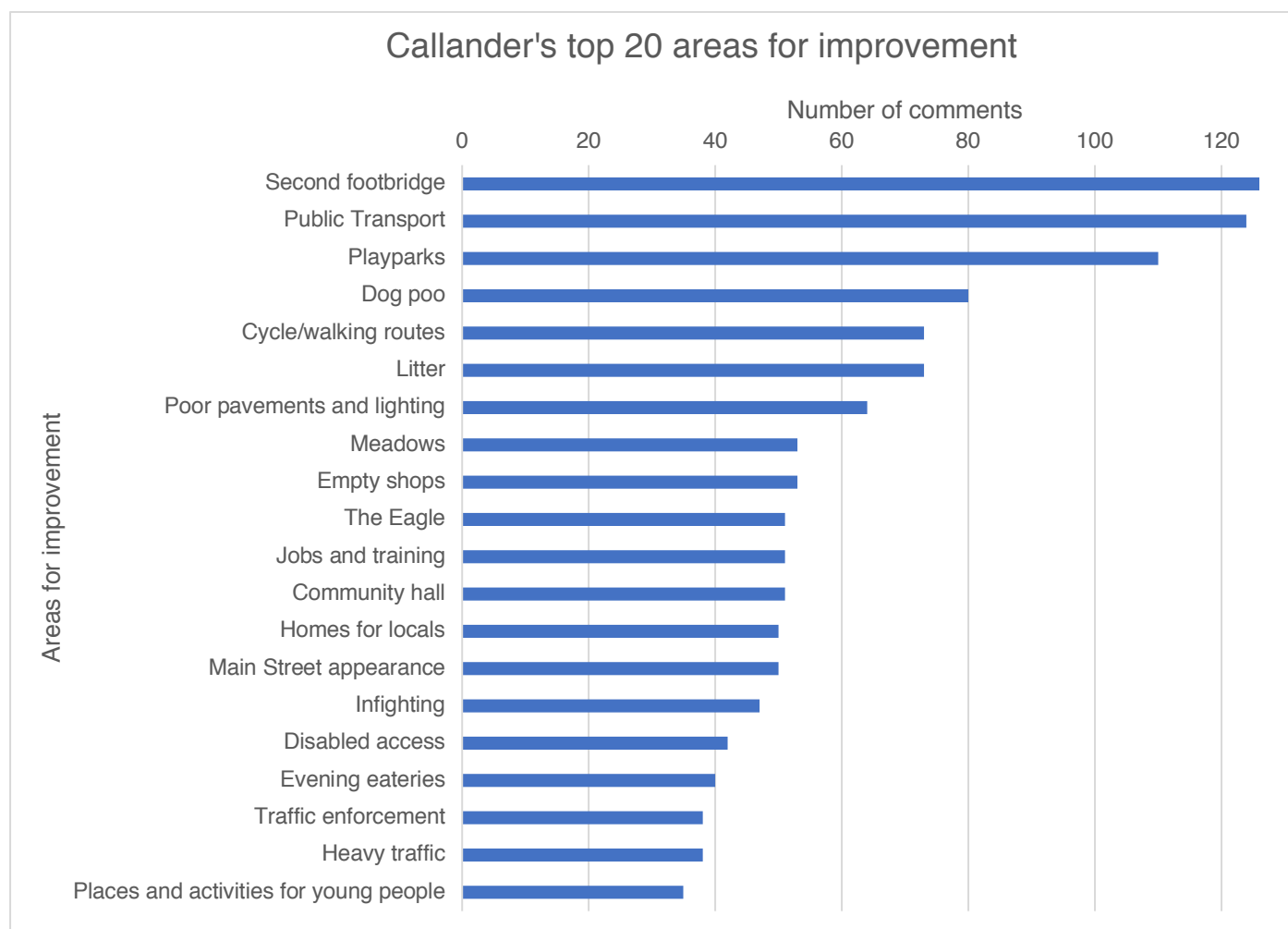


LPP update March 2022

The Place Standard Survey closed on February 28th. I attach (separately) the 'scores' for Callander as visualised using the Place Standard Tool.

There were 238 responses representing 230 Callander households. A total of 245 separate issues were raised, 26 of which were mentioned by one person only or relate to issues that are out with the reach of the LPP

I have compiled a list of the 20 individual issues that attracted the most comments. This is on the website, and I copy this here.



I am in the process of consolidating all comments received into themes. Rather than adhering to the Place Standard format of 14, I find that Callander's issues are better served if one looks at 12 overall areas. There are (at present):

- Streets, Paths & Pavements,
- Public Transport,
- Main Street,
- Young People,
- Community & Feeling Safe,

- Natural Environment & Climate Emergency
- Recreation & Play,
- Parking & Traffic,
- Tourism,
- Public realm,
- Homes,
- Public Services

Over the next 3 weeks I will be drafting the final public survey, based on local need, supporting Government policy and the potential for positive outcomes.
