

## Callander Community Council Meeting on Monday, 11<sup>th</sup>. April 2022 Motorhomes sub-group report

Following last month's CCC meeting, the subgroup had an online meeting with members of Killin CC, who are also seeking to provide motorhome provision for their area. It was an excellent meeting and the Chair sent a summary of what had been discussed to ME/JM to request what else could be done to speed things up, such as funding sources.

We also contacted SC, in reply to their update to us on this season's motorhome provision in Callander, where they had offered to re-line Station Road car park with 4 motorhome spaces as a pilot, with no other provision such as black/grey waste disposal or fresh water provision planned.

We advised them that CCC felt this offer to be of limited value, as there would be no incentive for motorhomes to use this car park rather than the Meadows car park and the pilot scheme would be likely to fail. The installation of electric hook ups (EHU) was not a necessity for the pilot, unlike waste and fresh water provision which was essential.

We also highlighted that Callander was a major hub for campervans/motorhomes travelling north. With the planned reduction of touring spaces available in Callander Woods caravan park, the situation was likely to get considerably worse. We suggested that it would be more appropriate to delay any pilot scheme until the minimum standards outlined by us could be met.

SC have respected our decision and have said that they will let us know what the proposed timetable could be for installing the facilities we had requested.

The sub-group is also in the process of looking for other sources of funding which may help to progress motorhome provision for Callander.
