Camp Place Play Park

Work has continued on the installation of the first part of the refurbished play park. To date the pendulum swing, the multiplay and the rope nets have been installed but are fenced off waiting for the grass to grow through the Safagrass matting and for the completion of safety checks. In addition, most of the pieces of gym equipment have been fully installed, also awaiting final checks.

Work on the toddler/inclusive play area has started with the swing frame and multiplay in place and the accessible roundabout currently installed and the area is in the process of being fenced.

The first part of the Green Recovery Award has been paid by the National Park with the second instalment due shortly. Payment for the fencing has been made from the Awards for All grant awarded to CCC.

Installation is due to be completed by the end of April.
